❖ **Suggestions and Recommendation by the Speakers**

Addresses by the District Collector

1. The PLF and volunteers need to have regular training program also refresher program to update their knowledge.
2. To ensure that every village in Perambalur District has one trained person or grass root level motivator.
3. The PLF will be to trigger and conduct interpersonal communications with the villagers to make the village ODF and further sustain the ODF status which include Solid Liquid Waste Management (SLWM).
4. There was a felt demand for training for grass root level motivators, and by empanelling KRCs they want to meet this demand by supplying the required number of training and capacity building needs. She said Perambalur District already achieve ODF District. So she strictly said all are continuously use the toilets and maintain properly.



Addresses by the PAC Consultant:

Dr.Sreedharan says Improving consumer voices as Accountability in the Swachh Bharat Mission in select six Districts each of Odhisha and Tamilnadu states aims examining whether a implementation will make a difference and lead to better and speedier in increasing rural toilet coverage.



Also we have conducted a study through the use of Social accountability tool to identify barriers to effective implementation, increase the voice of consumer in the SBM implementation. After exercise has been completed in both Odisha and Tamilnadu next step is Community Score card. It is a Social Accountability tool it aims to assess the quality of service delivery and the performance of the service provider.



Mr. Sridhar Project Director, DRDA, Perambalur explained the causes serious health problem and people suffer from various diseases and they spend their earnings to medicine. So all are must using the toilet. Not go for open defecation.



Dr. S. Uma Maheshwari, Project Director, TNSRLM explained about to use the toilet



constructed and insisted that all the family members must use the toilet. When go for open defecation, the flies sit on it and take the feaces to the food items, the human consume. It caused disease and children are suffering. She explained the subsidy [Rs.12, 000] available in government for toilet construction and make use of it.



The students must use the toilets in the school, so that they demand toilet in their house when it is not available. The children are called as sanitation ambassadors and she said to fence the open defecation area plant saplings must and to be raised by the all villagers. We have distributed folder like notepad, pen, sanitation pamphlets and also provide Thulasi seed ball. The main purpose of distributing the seed ball the seed can be saplings open defecation areas. The Thulasi seed ball sapling is prevent the Open defecation. The ends of the programme all are taken oath on sanitation message.
